The Election Commission of Bhutan is pleased to hereby declare, as required under Section 457 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan, 2008, that Mil Kumar Mongar of *Tagp-Thang-Bu Chiwog*, having secured **909** votes in the Bye-Elections with Polls held on 19th of September 2013, is duly elected to the post of *Gup* in Darla Gewog under Chhukha Dzongkhag.

3. Voter Turnout (%)	= 37.1


