REPORT ON THE STATUS OF DRUK NYAMRUP TSHOGPA (DNT)

BACKGROUND

1. In accordance with Section 209 (c) of Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2008 which provides for Political Parties in General Election to field Candidates from the Political Parties that do not qualify for the General Elections, seven Candidates of Druk Nyamrup Tshogpa (DNT) joined People's Democratic Party (PDP) as Candidates for 2013 General Election.
2. The Election Commission approved this move by the members of DNT upon forfeiting their membership, as provided in the Electoral Laws.
3. However, since it involved senior office bearers including the President and the Vice President of DNT joining PDP, questions were raised in public domain, referring to such move as merger of the two Parties, and doubted the existence of DNT as separate Political Entity.
4. Therefore, the ECB, in addition to providing clarifications to the stakeholders, its position on the decision as legitimate, notified the public through ECB Press Release No. ECB/CEC-PR/2013/4215 dated 17th of June 2013 (*Annexure A*) that a review shall be conducted to reaffirm on the Status of DNT as a registered Political Party under the Electoral Laws.

SUB-COMMITTEE

5. Towards this end, the Election Commission, vide office order no. ECB (CEC-14)2014/1388 dated 4th of March 2014 (*Annexure B*) constituted a Sub-Committee to review the status of DNT as a registered Political Party in

keeping with the decision of the Election Commission notified vide above Press Release.

6. Based on the Appointment Order, the Sub-Committee convened its first meeting on 10th of March 2014 and discussed on the yardsticks for reviewing the status of DNT as a registered Political Party.
7. Subsequent meetings reviewed the findings and information sought from the Political Parties.
8. The Review involved obtaining data from the Party Offices, meeting at official levels as well as meeting with Executive Members/General Secretary.

WORKING STRATEGY

9. Prior to beginning of review, the Sub-Committee as mandated in the appointment order prepared and submitted the working strategy presented as *Annexure C* which was immediately approved by the Commission.

COMPARATIVE STUDY

10. The status of Bhutan Kuen-Nyam Party (BKP) and Druk Chirwang Tshogpa (DCT) were also studied in order to compare the overall scenario and current activities carried out as registered Political Parties in the Post-Election Period.

REPORT OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE

11. The Sub-Committee submitted its Report on the status of DNT to the Commission vide Note sheet No.ECB/PEF-8/2014/1848 dated 8th of May

2014. The Commission convened a meeting on 12th of May 2014 to discuss on the findings and observations (*Annexure D*).

CRITERIA

12. The criteria used for the registration of the Political Party were applied as basis for the review of the current status of the DNT, BKP and DCT, while Financial and Membership Status of both Ruling (PDP) and Opposition (DPT) Parties were reviewed to gain an overall comparative perspective.

13. The following features or documents of the Parties were considered and examined.

1) Financial Statements for the period, 30th of June/Date of Last Audit - 31st of December 2013

The financial statements of the Political Parties were studied to see the financial status or progress for the period, 30th of June/Date of last Audit - 31st of December 2013 including the following:

- Amounts received by, or on behalf of the Party (Income);
- Amounts paid by, or on behalf of the Party (Expenditure); and
- Assets and liabilities accrued, by or on behalf of the Party (Balance Sheet).

2) Membership

The list of members registered with the Party were reviewed to see if reasonable number of members were mobilized to sustain the Political Party as well as whether the members registered with the Party were

broad-based with cross- national membership as required under the Electoral Laws.

3) Membership and Registration Fees

The rates of Membership and Registration fees fixed by the Party was examined.

4) Audit Report on the Financial Statements of the Political Parties by the RAA for the Financial Year 2012-13

The Audit Report on the Financial Statements of the Political Parties were studied to see if the Parties have maintained their books of accounts in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP).

5) Office bearers at Party Head office & Dzongkhag and Status of Party Offices in the Dzongkhag

The Office bearers at the Party Head Office and at the Dzongkhag level and the status of the Dzongkhag Party Offices were studied to see the operations and functions of the Parties.

6) Party Activities or Events

Any other activities or events undertaken by Political Parties were also reviewed and highlighted in the Review Report.

OBSERVATION AND FINDINGS

Income

14.DNT managed to generate a reasonable income with their income being slightly more than the total expenditure incurred as of 31st of December

2013. While BKP and DCT couldn't generate any income from the date of last audit till the 31st of December 2013, DNT managed to mobilize total amount of **Nu.327,380.00/-** as Voluntary Contributions from its registered members the details of which are presented as *Annexure 1*.

15. The DNT as of 31st of December, 2013 has a total saving of **Nu.388,186.78/-** while DCT and BKP have total savings of **Nu.64,854.00/-** and **Nu.740,208.00/-** respectively.

16. From 30th of June 2013 to 31st of December 2013, People's Democratic Party (PDP), the Ruling Party has managed to garner total amount of **Nu.2,145,040.00/-** as Voluntary Contributions from its registered members while, Druk Phuensum Tshogpa the Opposition Party has collected amounting to **Nu.2,544,400.00/-**.

17. As of 31st of December 2013, PDP has a total savings of **Nu.1,377,091.63/-** and DPT **Nu.2,732,539.58/-**.

Membership and Membership Fees

18. DNT saw an increase in the membership by 55.47% with current membership at 653 compared to 420 in 2013. The members registered are broad-based with cross-national membership as required under the Electoral Laws.

19. The current Membership Fee for DNT is fixed at Nu.100/- which is less than previous Membership Fee of Nu.1300/-. The Registration fee stands at Nu.200/- per member.

20. The decrease in membership for DCT is 10.75% with current membership at 606, compared to 679 in 2013.

The drop in membership for BKP is 5.08% with current membership at 392 compared to 413 in 2013.

21.The Membership Fee and Registration Fee of DCT stands at Nu. 50/- each, while for BKP the Membership Fee is fixed at Nu.500/- and one-time Registration Fee at Nu.100/- per member.

22.The Ruling Party, PDP, has 253 members registered while the Opposition Party, DPT, has 5,855 members registered as of 31st March, 2014.

23.PDP has fixed its Membership Fee at Nu.100 and Registration Fee at Nu.300. For DPT, the Registration and Membership Fees stands at Nu.50 each.

Party Structure and Offices

24.Since the resignation of the previous DNT President, the Party is currently headed by the Vice President.

25.The DNT has its offices in 18 Dzongkhags operating from the Coordinators' residences. For Thimphu Dzongkhag the Party Office is attached and is operating along with the Party Head Office and for Trashi Yangtse Dzongkhag the Party does not have a Dzongkhag Office.

26.For DCT & BKP the, Parties have their offices in 11 Dzongkhags coordinating from Coordinators' residence, while the Party Offices in 9 Dzongkhags are inactive.

ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS BY THE PARTY

27.The following were the activities undertaken by the DNT:

- 1) DNT conducted its Party Convention on 4th of March 2013, to elect its Party leaders and other office bearers.
- 2) The DNT regularly articulates alternative policies to the Government, through media, for instance, to go slow on implementation of Google Apps that might compromise our country's data sovereignty and security of our Nation.
- 3) DNT reaches out to public and stakeholders, for e.g. distribution through Kuensel supplement *Nyamrup Nyenzhu* – report to the people to keep supporters and voters informed of the status of the Party.
- 4) DNT fully involved in the public discourse forum such as BBS People's Voice program on the discussion "Economic Stimulus Plan –How best can we implement it?"It has plans for future contributions in the topical issues of national interest as and when the need arise.
- 5) DNT is active in multi-party discussion activities in order to discuss strengthening capacity building of the parties under the guidance of ECB in collaboration with Danish Institute for Parties and Democracies (DPID) Denmark.

28.DCT conducts monthly executive meetings to discuss issues and challenges confronting as a Political Entity and is also an active participant in the forums & panel discussions organised.

29.BKP regularly conducts meetings to discuss on the institutional strengthening and organizational development and also participated in

forums such as ACC workshop, DIPD meetings among others. The Party also has a plan to visit schools and universities across the country.

ISSUES FROM THE AUDIT REPORT ON THE ACCOUNTS AND OPERATIONS

30. While DNT saw few administrative lapses in maintaining their Books of Accounts and documents, the Party had generally maintained proper books of accounts and the financial statements were in agreement with the accounting records. The Audit Report on the Accounts and Operations of the DNT is for the period 01/07/2012 to 30/06/2013. The issues reflected in the Audit report and the Action Taken report by the Party is as follows:

1) Inadmissible payments

The Secretariat, had made a total payments of Nu.359,730.00/- on account of DSA, salary and transportation cost to 20 Constituency Coordinators and 86 Gewog Representatives who were not the registered members of the Party.

The Party submitted that the payments made were to the registered members who were Party workers in the Dzongkhag. The Payments (DSA and Transportation cost) to the Gewog Representatives were made during the Annual Party Convention held at RAPA hall, Thimphu on 4th of March 2013 to elect the office bearers of the Party including Party President, Vice President, General Secretary and others. The 20 Coordinators were paid Nu.6,500/- each as a salary during the Primary Round of Elections. Though the registration process was carried out in the respective Dzongkhags and since the membership forms were not submitted to the Party Head Office at the time of submission of Letter of

Intent to the ECB, the names were not reflected in the membership list. The Party had by then already paid to the coordinators for their services.

The Audit has required the Party to seek clarifications from the ECB on the admissibility of the payments on salary, DSA and Transportation Cost to Constituency Coordinators and Gewog Representatives who were not registered members of DNT, failing which the amount should be recovered.

2) Missing Money Receipts and Membership Forms

The Party had printed 180 Money Receipt booklets and 200 Membership Forms. However, on physical verification by the Auditors, it was observed that 68 money receipt booklets and 50 membership forms were found missing.

The money receipts booklets and membership forms were issued to the Candidates and the Dzongkhag Offices to carry out the registration process in their respective *Demkhongs*.

The Party Secretariat submitted that since the offices in the Dzongkhag failed to keep proper records and update the head office on the money receipts, many of the receipts were not returned at the time of Audit.

Despite all the efforts, the Party is still not able to recover the money receipts. The Party has been advised to follow the standard financial practices by allowing sufficient time to collect the documents failing which, the party will notify the public on the loss and cancellation of the receipt booklets.

The RAA has asked the Party Secretariat to trace the money receipts and membership forms and take appropriate measures to rule out the misuse of collections made from the use of missing Money Receipts booklets and membership forms.

31.The Secretariat, DCT had generally maintained proper books of accounts, and the financial statements were in agreement with the accounting records. However, the Party, shall be required to collect and deposit the amount of Nu.86,500/- which was not accounted for in the total revenue collection. The Audit Report on the Accounts and Operations of the DCT is for the period 01/01/2012 to 31/08/2013.

32.The Secretariat, BKP had generally maintained their books of accounts, and the financial statements were in agreement with the accounting records. The Audit Report on the Accounts and Operations of the BKP is for the period 01/01/2012 to 31/10/2013.The Auditor's review of the accounting records, internal controls and operation of BKP revealed some deficiencies and lapses. However, all the audit findings and issues were settled in view of the justifications, supporting documents and evidences furnished subsequently.

GENERAL OBSERVATION

33.Interactions with key office-bearers of DNT revealed that out of 47 Candidates, only 7 have resigned and rest is all intact.

34.The Party is run essentially by the Executive Committee comprising of former Candidates committed to long term institution building as a Party.

35. At the moment they are apprehensive about identifying a President in haste which might lead to mass withdrawal of membership and making the situation more difficult to garner support base for the Party.

36. The Party has plans to identify all Candidates by end of 2015 to prepare for the next Parliamentary Elections in earnest, including identifying potential President for the Party.

CONCLUSION

37. The Party has performed up to the satisfaction and undertaken several activities and events to keep its supporters and voters informed on the existence and status of the Party as a Political Entity.

38. The Party, since the completion of the Parliamentary Elections 2013 has become stronger in terms of an increase in membership by 55.47% comparison to that of 2013 with reasonable income to run the Party Offices and machineries.

39. It has actively participated in various forums and panel discussions organised by BBS.

40. The Party has generally maintained proper accounts and the financial statements were in agreement with the accounting records, except for few administrative issues on the account of Missing Money Receipts and inadmissible payments.

41. While the Party has its Offices in 18 Dzongkhags operating from the residences of the Coordinators, the Head Office in Thimphu is fully functional in a rented space.

42. The DNT is playing active role in setting up of public opinion and agenda of national interest and making its presence felt as a separate Political Entity.

43. In view of the above findings and observations, the status of DNT remains unaffected and continues to be a Registered Political Party under the Constitution fulfilling all criteria set in the Electoral Laws.

COURSE OF ACTION

44. The Election Commission during its meeting held on 12th of May 2014 deliberated on the findings and observations of the Sub-Committee and decided on the following:

- 1) DNT shall be required to discuss on the appointment of a Party President and intimate its outcome to the Election Commission as required under the Political Party Rules of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2012.
- 2) The Party shall furnish information to the ECB of the Dzongkhag Party Offices of the two Dzongkhags, Thimphu and Trashigang and indicate their addresses at which the public can make contact.
- 3) The Party shall take the necessary action on the Missing Money Receipts as per the standard legal procedures and conform to all acceptable norms and Laws.
- 4) The Party should ensure that proper control is exercised over the custody, use and accounting of money receipt and the Secretariat must issue instructions to the Dzongkhag Offices for timely surrender of used money receipts booklets along with amounts collected.

- 5) Accord equivalent monetary values for any voluntary time put in for Party works and account for the housing of the Dzongkhag Party Offices in private residences as per the current market value and formalise these in the form of Office Orders and accordingly account in the Parties' Books of Accounts as Voluntary Contributions of such registered members under acceptable norms.
 - 6) The Party has to resolve the pending audit issues within the period allowed and as per the requirements of the Royal Audit Authority and intimate the Action Taken Report to the ECB.
 - 7) It shall update the membership list as per Electoral Laws.
 - 8) The Party shall communicate to the ECB any changes in the head offices relating to its office bearers, addresses or any changes that are of significance and that need to be informed.
 - 9) Activities to be carried out by the Parties shall be in accordance with their respective annual work-plans shared with the Election Commission of Bhutan and as per the strategies within the framework of Party Charters, the Political Party Rules of the Kingdom of Bhutan, 2012 and abiding by the Code of Conduct prescribed under Section 290 -306 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2008.
- 45.A public Notification incorporating a gist of the observations and requirements shall be issued, as per resolution of the Commission adopted on 12th of May 2014. The issues to be fulfilled by the other registered


Political Parties including the Ruling and the Opposition Parties shall also be highlighted.

PRESS RELEASE

The Election Commission of Bhutan met with the President Jigmi Y. Thinley of Druk Phuensum Tshogpa (DPT), President Tshering Tobgay of People's Democratic Party (PDP) and Dr. Tandi Dorji, Representative of Druk Nyamrup Tshogpa (DNT) on 10th of June 2013.

The main reason for calling the meeting was the issue of the perceived and possible resultant coalition in connection with PDP seeking to replace seven Candidates with those from DNT for the General Elections under Section 209 (c) of the Election Act 2008, which was necessary to be addressed with the relevant and direct stakeholders.

The gist of the proceedings and understanding reached at the meeting, as reflected in the Final Record of the Meeting handed over to the three Political Parties, is hereby shared to inform with the general public on this important matter:

1. ECB drew the attention of the meeting to the Sections 5 and 6 of the Article 15 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Bhutan which essentially provide that the General Elections shall be contested only by the two Political Parties selected through the Primary Round, which is contested by all registered and eligible Political Parties.

At the same time, the Section 209 (c) of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan provides the opportunity to the two Political Parties to replace their Original Candidates with Candidates from the Parties that did not make it to the General Election i.e. DNT and DCT. However, Political Parties were cautioned against the misuse of this provision to effect a Coalition in Parliament and/or Government as the Constitution allows only two Parties in the National Assembly of Bhutan. Thus, it is very clear that a Candidate who leaves a party to join another one automatically forfeits his/her membership in the original Party in favour of total allegiance and support to the welcoming Party and its Manifesto.

2. DPT President asked to be convinced that there is no merger between the Parties. PDP President said that seven replacement Candidates from DNT are being proposed and the discussions with them were carried out at the individual level. No payments were made to original PDP Candidates of these seven *Demkhongs*. The DNT Representative said that the Party had no involvement in the decision of the Candidates to join the PDP and it was purely the individual's decision as the Party told the Candidates that the Party cannot be involved and it is upto the individual to make their own decision.

The DNT Representative asked the DPT on the enactment of the Section 209 (c) of the Election Act, which has gained such prominence at this point of time, as DPT was the Ruling Party at that time. DPT President responded that as the question was a sincere one he would also respond with the same sincerity in that the Constitution, Election Act and a couple of other Acts had been enacted in the very first Session of Parliament in a speedy manner without too much analysis and scrutiny principally in recognition of the work done in the past for the transition to democracy besides which there were very few Members then who had experience in law-making.

3. All Parties agreed on the need to ensure that the letter as well as spirit of the Constitution and the Laws are upheld and said they are committed to abide by the laws at all times.
4. The Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) acknowledged the assurance of all Parties to conform their actions to the Laws.

He also placed on record that the ECB had met with the DPT team in the forenoon of Friday, the 7th of June 2013 and in the afternoon of the same day met the PDP Team which came to the ECB with a list of nine names of DNT Candidates it was proposing to nominate as its Candidates under Section 209 (c). The ECB gave PDP its “Opinion” on Sunday, 9th of June 2013, which was not a legally binding document. He stated five names were recommended based on the ECB’s understanding of the intent of the said provision while it could not object to the other four names listed as it did not have direct legal basis to do so. A letter from DPT on this issue was brought to the ECB by two of its Members, (the letter subsequently released to the media by the DPT), and it had been explained to them that the matter would be discussed in the Party meeting that was called in the afternoon (*the meeting under reference here*). No specific response from ECB to this letter was found necessary as issues raised in it were dealt in detail in the subsequent meeting attended by the DPT President.

5. The CEC apprised that hereafter if there are substantive grounds to believe there was any violation of the Laws, appropriate actions would be initiated including disqualification of Candidature or cancellation of Membership in Parliament.
6. He stated that the status of DNT as a Political Party will be reviewed after the National Assembly Elections.
7. The CEC reemphasized that ECB cannot be expected to police the Parties nor it is desirable to do so. It does not intend to interfere in the everyday affairs of Political Parties nor would it base its decision on hearsay in the media and the community. It will respect the maturity and accountability of the leadership of the Parties. However, it is committed to uphold the Constitution and where warranted, it is determined to be firm and take tough decisions.

**Working Strategy for the Review of the Status of Druk Nyamrup Tshogpa (DNT) as
a Political Party**

Working Strategy
For
the Review of the Status of Druk Nyamrup Tshogpa (DNT) as a Political
Party

Back Ground

1. In accordance with Section 209 (c) of Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2008 which provides for Political Parties in General Election to field Candidates from the Political Parties that do not qualify for the General Elections, seven Candidates of Druk Nyamrup Tshogpa (DNT) joined People's Democratic Party (PDP) as Candidates for 2013 General Election.
2. The Election Commission approved this move by the members of DNT upon forfeiting their membership, as provided in the Electoral Laws.
3. However, since it involved senior office bearers including the President and the Vice President of DNT joining PDP, questions were raised in public domain, referring to such move as merger of the two Parties, and doubted the existence of DNT as different Political Entity.
4. Therefore, the ECB, in addition to providing clarifications to the stakeholders, its position on the decision as legitimate, notified the public through ECB Press Release No. ECB/PR/2013/4215 dated 17th of June 2013 that a review shall be conducted on the Status of DNT as a registered Political Party under the Electoral Laws.

Appointment of Sub-Committee

5. Towards this end, the Election Commission, vide office order no. ECB (CEC-14)2014/1388 dated 4th of March 2014 constituted a Sub-Committee to review the status of DNT as a registered Political Party in keeping with the decision of the Election Commission notified vide above Press Release.

Meeting of the Sub-Committee

6. Based on the Appointment Order, the Sub-Committee convened its first meeting on 10th of March 2014 and discussed on the yardsticks for reviewing the status of DNT as a registered Political Party.

Working Strategy

7. The Sub-Committee, as mandated, decided to prepare and submit this working strategy for approval of the Election Commission prior to beginning the review. The following parameters were discussed as general framework for the review.

Comparative Study

8. The status of Bhutan Kuen-Nyam Party (BKP) and Druk Chirwang Tshogpa (DCT) will also be studied in order to compare the overall scenario and current activities carried out as registered Political Parties in the post-election period.

Criteria

9. Same criteria followed for the registration of the Political Party will be used as basis for the review of the current status of the DNT as well as BKP and DCT.
10. In particular, the following features or documents of the Parties will be considered and examined.

a) Financial Statements for the period, 30th of June - 31st of December 2013

The sub-committee will review the financial statements of the Political Parties to see the financial status or progress for the period, 30th of June - 31st of December 2013 including the following:

- Amounts received by, or on behalf of the Party (Income);
- Amounts paid by, or on behalf of the Party (Expenditure); and
- Assets and liabilities accrued, by or on behalf of the Party (Balance sheet).

b) Membership

The list of members registered with the Party will be reviewed to see if enough members are mobilized to sustain the Political Party as well as whether the members registered with the Party are broad based with cross-national membership as required under the Electoral Laws.

c) Membership and Registration Fees

The rates on Membership and Registration fees fixed by the Party shall be reviewed and if required the Parties would be asked to submit the financial strategy adopted by the Party in order to ensure the sustainability of Party as a viable institution.

d) Audit Report on the Financial Statements of the Political Parties by the RAA for the Financial Year 2012-13

The Audit Report on the Financial Statements of the Political Parties will be considered to see if the Parties have maintained their books of accounts in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP).

e) Office bearers at Party Head office & Dzongkhag and Status of Party Offices in the Dzongkhag

The Office bearers at the Party Head Office and at the Dzongkhag level and the status of the Dzongkhag Party Offices shall be reviewed to see the operations and functions of the Parties.

f) Party Activities or Events

Any other activities or events undertaken by Political Parties will be highlighted in the Review Report.

Meetings with Party Representatives

11. Regular meetings if needed will be held at official level with the Parties' Representatives to seek clarifications or solicit further details of information.

12. As per Officer Order No. ECB/CEC-14/2014/1541 dated 14th of March 2014, all correspondences related to the review of DNT shall be communicated formally under the name and sign of the Chairperson.

Sub-Committee Report

13. The Sub-Committee shall prepare a report on the Status of the Political Parties and submit to the Election Commission as per the approved time-frame as in *Annexure II*.

Final Decision

14. The Election Commission, upon review of the report of the Sub-Committee arrive at a decision on the status of DNT and if necessary hold meetings with the Party.

15. The Election Commission, after considering all facts and issues, will take the final decision that would be notified to general public through a Notification in the month of May 2014.

1. The Chair of the Sub-Committee, in general, briefed the meeting that the review was conducted thoroughly as per the approved strategy and criteria through obtaining information and clarification at official levels by the Public Election Fund Division from Party offices as well as interactions with the Executive Members/ General Secretary by Sub-Committee Members directly. He also informed the meeting on the plans of institutionalizing the DNT as shared by the General Secretary, particularly their strategy to identify all Candidates by 2015 instead of waiting till the last moment in 2018, hence they have not yet elected a President lest it might undermine support they enjoy currently run jointly by Vice President supported by Executive Committee.
 2. The Fund Manager presented the Sub-Committee Report on the Status of DNT as a registered Political Party. He informed that based on the approved Strategy Document the Sub-Committee reviewed the Status of DNT. Same criteria for the registration of the Political Party were used as basis for the review of the current status of the DNT, BKP and DCT, while Financial and Membership Status of both Ruling (PDP) and Opposition (DPT) Parties were reviewed to gain an overall comparative perspective.

3. He reported on the following areas on which the documents of the Political Parties were reviewed and examined.
 - a) Financial Statements for the period, 30th of June/Date of Last Audit - 31st of December 2013;
 - b) Membership;
 - c) Membership Fees and Registration Fees;
 - d) Audit Report of the Political Parties;
 - e) Office bearers at Party Head Office and Status of Party Offices in the Dzongkhag; and
 - f) Party Activities or Events
4. He informed that DNT has managed to generate a reasonable income and had mobilized a total amount of **Nu.327,380.00/-** as Voluntary Contributions from its registered members. He said that though the Party had reduced its membership fees from Nu.1300/- to Nu.100/- the Party saw an increase in the membership by 55.47% with current membership at 653 compared to 420 in 2013.
5. The Fund Manager reported that the Party has generally maintained proper accounts and the financial statements were in agreement with the accounting records, except for few administrative issues on the account of Missing Money Receipts and inadmissible payments. On the account of Party structure and Offices he said that DNT has Party offices in 18 Dzongkhags operating from Coordinator's residences while, the Head Office in Thimphu is fully functional in a rented space.
6. On the activities and events undertaken by the DNT, he informed that the Party is playing active role in setting up of public opinion and agenda of national interest and making its presence felt as a separate Political Entity. It has also actively participated in various forums and panel discussions organised by BBS.
7. In addition the Chair of the Sub-Committee said that the DNT informed the Committee that the Party still has intact the remaining 40 Candidates and increased its support base. He said that though the Party at the moment is anxious about identifying a Party President, at the same time also concerned that such an appointment might lead to mass withdrawal of membership, making the situation more difficult to garner support base for the Party.

8. Aum Deki Pema, the Election Commissioner said that the report of the Sub-Committee was comprehensive covering membership & fee structure; Dzongkhag Office set up; activities during post elections; Audit findings etc. and pointed out that mechanism in the form of an active Executive Committee is in place to manage the Party. However, the DNT might have to have a Party President as required by the Electoral Laws.
9. The Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) said that the Press Release issued earlier and the Appointment Order of the Sub-Committee needs to be annexed in the Report. The Sub-Committee was also suggested for preparation of a Report of the Commission which would then be printed and shared with relevant agencies and stakeholders.

Resolution

10. The meeting resolved the following:
 - 1) The Report on Status of the DNT shall be finalised and notified to public at the earliest, incorporating the requirements to be fulfilled by the Parties, upon attaching as annexure, the copies of the Press Releases issued earlier and the Appointment Order of Sub-Committee.
 - 2) DNT shall be required to discuss on the appointment of a Party President and intimate its outcome to the Election Commission as required under the Political Party Rules of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2012.
 - 3) The Party shall also provide to ECB the location and proper address of all 20 Dzongkhag Offices and the registration number of the members registered with the Party.
 - 4) The Party shall incorporate the value of in-kind Contribution after working out its valuation as per the fair market value and shall account in the Parties' Books of Accounts as Voluntary Contributions of such registered members under acceptable norms.
 - 5) The Party shall follow the standard legal procedures and conform to all acceptable norms and Laws on the Missing Money Receipts.

6) The Notification to be issued on the Status of DNT shall also highlight the comparative findings and issues related to the other four Political Parties.

11. Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner commended the Sub-Committee for its efforts in furnishing the report and, for record, acknowledged the support and cooperation received from the respective Political Parties in the process of review conducted.
