NOTIFICATION

Bye-Elections and Election to Local Government for the vacant *Demkhongs*.

The Election Commission of Bhutan, in pursuance to Sections 577 and 579 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2008, hereby calls for Bye-Elections and Elections in the remaining vacant *Demkhongs* under the Constitution of the Kingdom of Bhutan for the following posts:

1. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* of Betso_ Doomchhog under Uesu of Haa Dzongkhag;
2. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* of Tabi under Kurtoed Gewog of Lhuentse Dzongkhag;
3. *Thromde Tshogde Tshogpa* of Samdrup Gatshel under Samdrup Jongkhar Thromde;
4. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* of Tamigdamchhu_Thangbji under Toedwang Gewog under Punakha Dzongkhag;
5. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* of Ura-Dozhi under Ura Gewog of Bumthang Dzongkhag;
6. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* of Dilibkha_Lamjokha under Geling Gewog of Chhukha Dzongkhag;
7. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* of Chong-Geykha_Dophulakha under Phuentsholing Gewog of Chhukha Dzongkhag;
8. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* of Deling_Marpji under Phuentsholing Gewog of Chhukha Dzongkhag;
9. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* of Nyingshingborang under Norboogang Gewog of Pema Gatshel Dzongkhag;

10. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa of Dochhukha_Dzomlingthang_Ritsa* under *Guma Gewog of Punakha Dzongkhag*;
11. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa of Chhunag_Dumshinggang* under *Phuentshogpelri Gewog of Samtse Dzongkhag*;
12. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa of Dewachen_Zhiwaling* under *Tashichhoeling Gewog of Samtse Dzongkhag*;
13. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa of Khabaabgang_Noryog* under *Norgaygang of Samtse Dzongkhag*;
14. *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa of Chhemkhar_Manam* under *Toedtsho Gewog of Trashy Yangtse Dzongkhag*

The Election Schedule and the details concerning *Demkhongs*, Selection Procedure for Nomination of Candidates, Electoral Rolls, EVMs, Polling Stations, Polling Officials, Polling Management, Security and other arrangements are hereby being notified as follows:

(A) Election Schedule

1. The Schedule shall be as follows:

16 th of January 2014 (Thursday)	- Commencement of Signature Process by Eligible Candidates for the post of <i>Tshogpa</i>
22 nd of January 2014 (Wednesday)	- Last Date for filing of Nominations of Candidates
23 rd of January 2014 (Thursday)	- Scrutiny of Nominations of Candidates & Commencement of the Election Campaign
25 th of January 2014 (Saturday)	- Last date for withdrawal of Candidature
31 st of January 2014 (Friday)	-End of Election Campaign (8.00 AM)

3 rd of February 2014 (Monday)	Poll Day and Counting of Results
4 th of February 2014 (Tuesday)	- Declaration of Results & Submission of the Results to the Druk Gyalpo - Start of Election Petition Period
5 th of February 2014 (Wednesday)	- Issuance of the Certificate of Election
17 th of February 2014 (Monday)	- End of Election Petition Period

(B) Polling Hours

2. The polling hours shall be from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(C) Demkhong

3. The name and boundary of the *Demkhong* to be used shall be as written in the Order No. **DC/CHAIR/2011/1520** of **27th of February 2011**.

(D) Selection Process of the Candidates

4. A registered voter who fulfills the criteria laid down in Section 178 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2008 is eligible to be nominated as a Candidate for Election.
5. A Registered Voter aspiring to contest *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* Election shall produce signatures of at least 5 percent of the Registered Voters from the *Chiwog* supporting his/her nomination provided it is from at least 5 different *Gungs* and no voter or *Gung* has supported more than one Nominee.

(E) Electoral Roll

6. **The Electoral Roll used for the General Election 2013** shall be used as the basis with further revision as per the qualifying Date. All those registered in the Final Electoral Roll shall be eligible to vote in the concerned *Demkhong*.
7. The qualifying date for the Electoral Roll shall be the **1st of January 2014** therefore; all those who are not younger than eighteen years of age as on **1st of January 2014** or born on or before **1st of January 1996** shall be deemed to meet the minimum age requirement to be a voter.
8. No changes shall be made to the Electoral Roll after **3rd of January 2014**. However, the respective Dzongkhag Election Office shall continue to distribute the Voter Photo Identity Cards to those who were unable to collect it earlier even up to the Poll Day.
9. The Final Electoral Roll for the Election shall be published and provided to the Returning Officer on **22nd of January 2014** and to the Candidates on **23rd of January 2014**.

(F) Election Campaign

10. A Candidate shall have up to **8** days for campaigning, which must stop 48 hours before the start of Poll.
11. No Minister, Member of Parliament, official or member of a political party or elected member of Local Government shall campaign directly or indirectly for any Candidate. No trips or official tours shall be undertaken by a Minister or Member of Parliament to a *Demkhong* during the Election Period except to cast their votes on the Poll Day should they wish not to use the Postal Ballot facility extended to them and their spouse under Section 331 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2008.

12. The other elected Local Government officials i.e. the Gup, *Mangmi*, *Dzongkhag Thromde Thuemi*, *Thrompon*, *Thromde Tshogde Tshogpa* and *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* shall not campaign directly or indirectly for any Candidate and shall only participate as a voter on the Poll day.

Election Campaign Finance

13. A Candidate cannot exceed his/her election campaign expense beyond the ceiling fixed in Section 59 of the Public Election Fund Act 2008 i.e. total of Nu. 50,000/-.

Election Campaign Returns

14. A Candidate must file Election Returns within thirty days of declaration of the Election Result as per the prescribed procedures.
15. Election Commission of Bhutan shall maintain a list of all contesting Candidates (elected or not elected) who failed to lodge accounts of election expenses within the time and in manner required under Section 179 (d) of the Election Act will result in being barred from participation in future elections.

(G) Postal Ballots

16. The Postal Voter List shall be based on Postal Voters Registration for the *Second Parliamentary Election 2013*.
17. The schedule for the processing of Postal Ballots shall be as given below:

Date and Time	Remarks
14 th of January 2014	- Eligible Postal Voters to initiate application for Postal Ballot to the Returning Officer
25 th of January 2014	- Last date of receipt of Application for Postal Ballots by Returning Officer - Returning Officer to

	commence sending Postal Ballot to registered Postal Voters
2 nd of February 2014	- Last day/ time for receiving Postal Ballots
3 rd of February 2014	- Poll Day and Counting of Results

(H) Voter Photo Identity Card (VPIC)

18. Voter Photo Identity Card (VPIC) issued by the Election Commission shall be the valid document for identification of voters at the Polling Stations during the Elections.
19. However, all voters must carry with them the Citizenship Identity Card issued by the Ministry of Home and Cultural Affairs. In the event of any dispute related to the VPIC, the Citizenship Identity Card will form the basis for taking decision by the Presiding Officer.

(I) Electronic Voting Machines

20. The Electronic Voting Machine (EVM) shall be used for polling in all the Polling Station.

(J) Indelible Ink

21. Quality indelible ink shall be used during the elections and care must be taken in applying the indelible ink on the **left Index Finger.**

(K) Polling Stations

22. The Polling Stations shall be as indicated in the Final Electoral Roll

(L) Election Officials

Election Coordinators

23. The *Dzongdags* shall be appointed as the Chief Election Coordinators, *Dzongrabs/Dungpas* as the Deputy Chief Election Coordinator and the *Gewog Administrative Officers* as the Assistant Chief Election Coordinators in the respective Gewog. All Election Officials appointed hereof shall be responsible for carrying out the roles, responsibilities and duties as provided in the Electoral Laws, the Appointment Order issued by the Election Commission on **13th of January 2014** and vested with authority, Roles and Responsibilities as per provisions in the Electoral Roll Laws, Rules, Regulations and Guide Lines and Respective Handbooks.

Returning Officers

24. The Election Commission shall appoint the Dzongkhag Electoral Officer as the Returning Officer for the conduct of the Election and shall observe the Elections in the respective Dzongkhag as a National Observer.

Presiding and Polling Officers

25. The appointment of Presiding Officers and Polling Officers for the Elections shall be as per the Appointment Orders issued by the Returning Officer on or before 4th of February 2014 i.e. three days before the day of Poll, unless otherwise authorised.

Counting Supervisors & Counting Assistants

26. The Presiding Officers shall serve as the Counting Supervisors and a Polling Officer as the Counting Assistant, authorized as such in the Appointment Orders issued by the concerned Returning Officer.

Assignment of Duty Stations

27. The Election Officials shall not be posted to the Gewog where his/her *Gung* or *Mitsi* is registered.

(M) Law and Order & Deployment of Forces

28. The *Dzongdags* and the Gewog Administrative Officers in the *Gewogs* shall serve as the Focal Points for all administrative matters in the *Dzongkhag* and *Gewog* respectively for the election period.
29. The *Dzongdags* and the Gewog Administrative Officer shall be responsible to ensure that the jurisdictions under their control are conducive and congenial for the conduct of free and fair elections.
30. All Election Officials must remain in their station during the entire election period.
31. The Royal Bhutan Police shall be responsible for security as per the Election Security Rules and Regulations of the Kingdom of Bhutan.
32. The Election Security Focal Officers of the concerned *Dzongkhag* shall work in close coordination and cooperation with the election officers as a team towards conducting the elections smoothly.

(N) Election Control Rooms

33. Control Rooms shall be established in the Office of the Returning Officer and at the Election Commission Headquarters to effectively supervise, direct, monitor and backstop the conduct of elections.

34. The Control Rooms shall be set up and function in the manner detailed in the *Manual for Control Rooms*.

(O) Election Code of Conduct

35. The Election Code of Conduct shall continue to be in force until the completion of the Election Period i.e. **from 15th of January 2014 to 17th of February 2014.**

36. All Election Officers, Candidates and Voters must comply with the Election Code of Conduct and the provisions of the Electoral Laws, Rules and Regulations and Guidelines.

(P) Poll Day - A Public Holiday

37. The Poll Day, **3rd of February 2014**, shall be declared as a Public Holiday in the concerned *Demkhong*. All employers are required by law to grant required number of days as election leave for any registered voter from the *Demkhong* wishing to go to vote in person.


(Q) Only One Candidate

38. If there is only one Candidate after the last date of filing of nomination of Candidates announced herein, an uncontested election, in accordance with Sections 575 and 576 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2008 will be conducted.

Now, thereof, from the day of issue of this Notification, the Election Commission of Bhutan notifies the general public on the Election Schedule of the **Bye-Elections and Election to Local Government for the vacant *Demkhongs*** and all matters relating to it.
