The Election Commission of Bhutan is pleased to hereby declare, as required under Section 457 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2008, the Results of the Bye-Election to the post of Gup in Chang Gewog under Thimphu Dzongkhag and Gewog Tshogde Tshogpas in Ngalmang_Phanteng Chiwog under Trashi Yangtse Dzongkhag, Narphoong Chiwog under Samdrup Jongkhar Dzongkhag and PemaYoedling Chiwog under Sarpang Dzongkhag.

As no voter came forward to file nomination for the post of *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* in Betsamang *Chiwog* under Trashhi Yangtse Dzongkhag, the seat will have to remain vacant.

It is also hereby being notified that as per Section 580 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan, 2008, the member elected to fill the casual vacancy shall only serve for the remainder term of the 2nd Local Government. The Election Petition period starts from 21st of June 2019 and shall end at 5.00 p.m. on 4th of July 2019.
