**Declaration of the Results of Bye-Elections for the post of Gup and Gewog Tshogde
Tshogpas**

The Election Commission of Bhutan is pleased to hereby declare, as required under Section 457 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan 2008, the Results of the Bye-Election to the post of Gup of Boomdeling *Gewog* under Trashi Yangtse Dzongkhag and *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpas* of Dorithasa_Kowkha_Yangtse *Chiwog* of Gakiling *Gewog* under Haa Dzongkhag, Pemachhoeling *Chiwog* of Tareythang *Gewog* under Sarpang Dzongkhag & Jomphu *Chiwog* of Soe *Gewog* under Thimphu Dzongkhag.

The details of the candidates who have been successfully elected as *Gup* and *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpas* are as follows:

The overall Voter Turnout and Registered Voter information are as follows:

 - ii. **Postal Ballot = 154**

As no voter came forward to file nomination for the post of *Gewog Tshogde Tshogpa* in Betsamang *Chiwog* under Trashi Yangtse Dzongkhag, the seat will have to remain vacant.

It is also hereby being notified that as per Section 580 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan, 2008, the member elected to fill the casual vacancy shall only serve for the remainder term of the 2nd Local Government. The Election Petition period starts from 26th of September 2019 and shall end at 5.00 p.m. on 9th of October 2019 for all except Jomphu *Chiwog* where the Election Petition will end on 15th of October 2019 due to Local Holidays.
