Public Notification

This is to inform the general public that the Election Commission of Bhutan (ECB) is in receipt of letter No. RAA/AG-SP/16/2021-2022/113 dated 6th December, 2021 from the Royal Audit Authority (RAA) concerning its decision to reconsider the audit clearances of 9 candidates that had been revoked earlier. Upon receipt of the RAA's decision and following a thorough review of the matter and relevant electoral laws, the ECB has decided to reschedule the elections for the following posts in the 8 affected Gewogs of the ongoing LG elections, 2021:

The rescheduling of elections in these Gewogs will begin with filing of nominations by these 9 candidates whose audit clearances had been revoked by the RAA earlier. In the meanwhile, the election process for the other posts in the affected Gewogs, namely, Mangmis and Tshogpas (with the exception of Tshogpa of Changyul_Loongsilgang_Tashijong under Guma Gewog) will proceed as per the schedule for the ongoing LG Elections, 2021 with poll day that has already been fixed on 22nd December, 2021. The details of the election schedule is as presented below:
