All eligible voters are urged to verify and ensure that you are included in the Electoral Roll and the details are correctly reflected. A Claim (i.e corrections against wrongful or non-entry of one's information in the Electoral Roll) and/or an Objection (i.e objecting to someone who has been wrongfully included in the Electoral Roll) if any, must be reported to the nearest Election Office.

In the meanwhile, the ECB is pleased to notify the public that the postal ballot registration timeline has been extended up to 27th October, 2023.
